Some of our areas of assistance are:

1. Ordaining of Ministerial positions
2. Recognition of prior learning from 1 year certificates and above
3. Formal study opportunities from short course and 1 year certificates to doctorate level
4. Establishing infrastructure
5. Establishing Satellite College Structures

Applying for ordination will require the following documents:

1. Copy of Id
2. Complete CV
3. Proof of address
4. Letter from church leadership
5. Copies of all relevant certificates
6. Ordination fee (according level)

This enables compliance with government regulations.

The Interdenominational Council's registered ministerial certificate are as follows: Assistant Pastor, Pastor, Executive Pastor, Bishop, and Archbishop.

Therefore, it is imperative that each ministry candidate supply us with their CV and a motivational letter from their current church leadership. Ordinations are done at our formal graduations but posted certificates are optional.
